Requirements:

- U.S. citizenship (evidence to be provided afterwards)
- Enrolled in Fall 2018 in an undergraduate or graduate program in Puerto Rico: BS, BE, MS, PhD
- A minimum of 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale (transcript)
- Academic progress according to schedule (transcript)
- Cover Page (1 page – form provided)
- Statement of Professional Goals (1 page)
- Research Plan (3-5 pages) signed by applicant and research advisor. The Research Plan must contain the following parts: 1) Summary; 2) Goals and Objectives; 3) Relevance to NASA according to NASA Technology Roadmap(s); 4) Collaboration(s) with NASA Center(s) or other National Lab(s); 5) Milestones and Timeline for Aug 2018 – May 2019; 6) References Cited
- Curriculum Vitae (1-2 pages) including peer-reviewed publications, proceedings, and presentations in local, national and international conferences
- Two letters of recommendation (one from advisor)

Academic Year Stipend:      PhD \$1,700 per month  
   MS \$1,200 per month  
   BS & BE \$800 per month

Tuition Assistance:            \$1,500 for PhD and MS Students  
(per semester)                \$1,000 for BS and BE Students
